



Hop to it with an Easter Bunny

GET READY...

- Cream or white card 21x14.9cm folded in half
- Piece of red card 8.5x13cm
- Beige/brown paper or thin card
- Piece of glossy white paper
- Peel-off greeting and leftover borders
- Glue, scissors etc
- Flower from ribbon (optional)

GO

STEP 1

Photocopy templates and cut out rabbit's head less hat, lip and collar. Copy outline onto beige/brown paper. Now cut into photocopy around the eyes, hair bundle

Margit Rigden's regular projects for youngsters to have a go at with a bit of adult help - or for grown-ups to play with on their own! This month's card conjures up an Easter Bunny,

and inside the front ear. Copy the lines to your beige/brown paper so you can see position of the eyes, hair and inner ear.

STEP 2

Cut out collar, hair, lip, eyes and hat, copy onto white plain or glossy paper, colour and cut out. Remember to cut the overlapping brown parts where indicated which are glued underneath the head. The eyes must be cut precisely as they are glued on top in the marked positions. Glue collar, lip, hair and eyes in position. Colour the eyes black and brown.

STEP 3

The coloured hat needs a slot along the rim bottom in order to slip into position on the rabbit's head. Cutting along the ear bit on either side and then along the rim, stopping before the ends, will make it easier and gives more stability. Slip into position and glue.

STEP 4

While the head is drying, prepare your base card. Glue the dark red card piece in the centre with double-sided sticky tape or glue stick. Use a left over peel-off border strip to decorate the red card edge.

STEP 5

Position and glue head on the base card, but leave the upper ears unglued so you can bend them forward a bit.

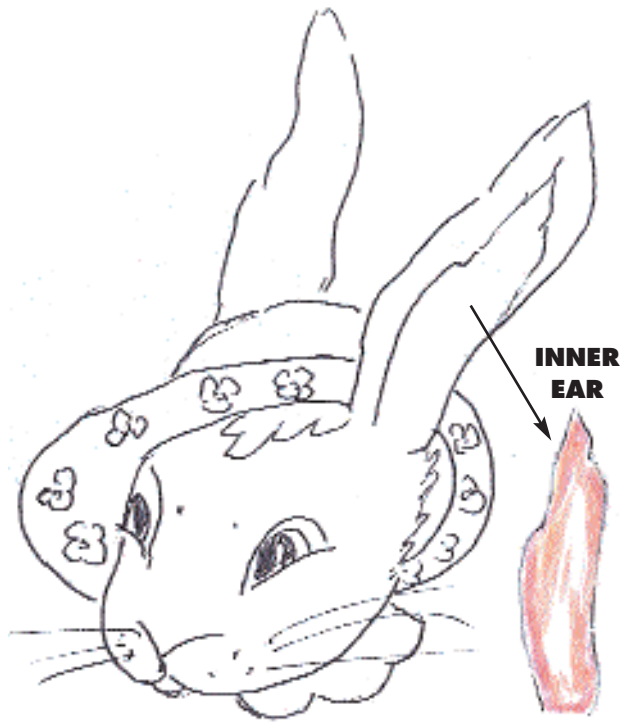
STEP 6

Cut pink inner ear and glue in position. Shade the head slightly (see example card).

STEP 7

Copy and cut out paws from brown paper and the egg from any colour you like. Decorate the egg to your taste and stick the 'Happy Easter' greeting on it or to the base card. Glue egg in position with the paws on top so the rabbit appears to be holding it.

For extra effect use paper gloss on the eyes and glue a ribbon flower on the rabbit's hat.

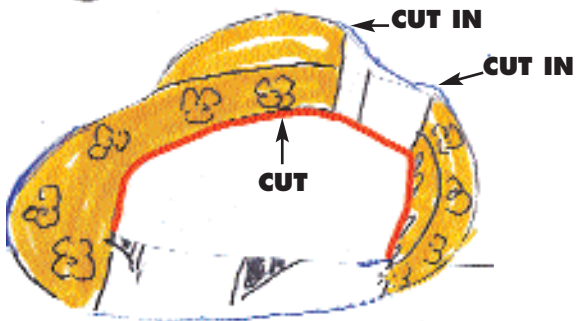

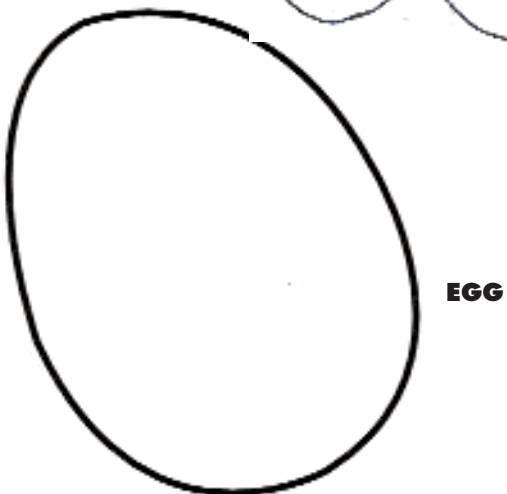
