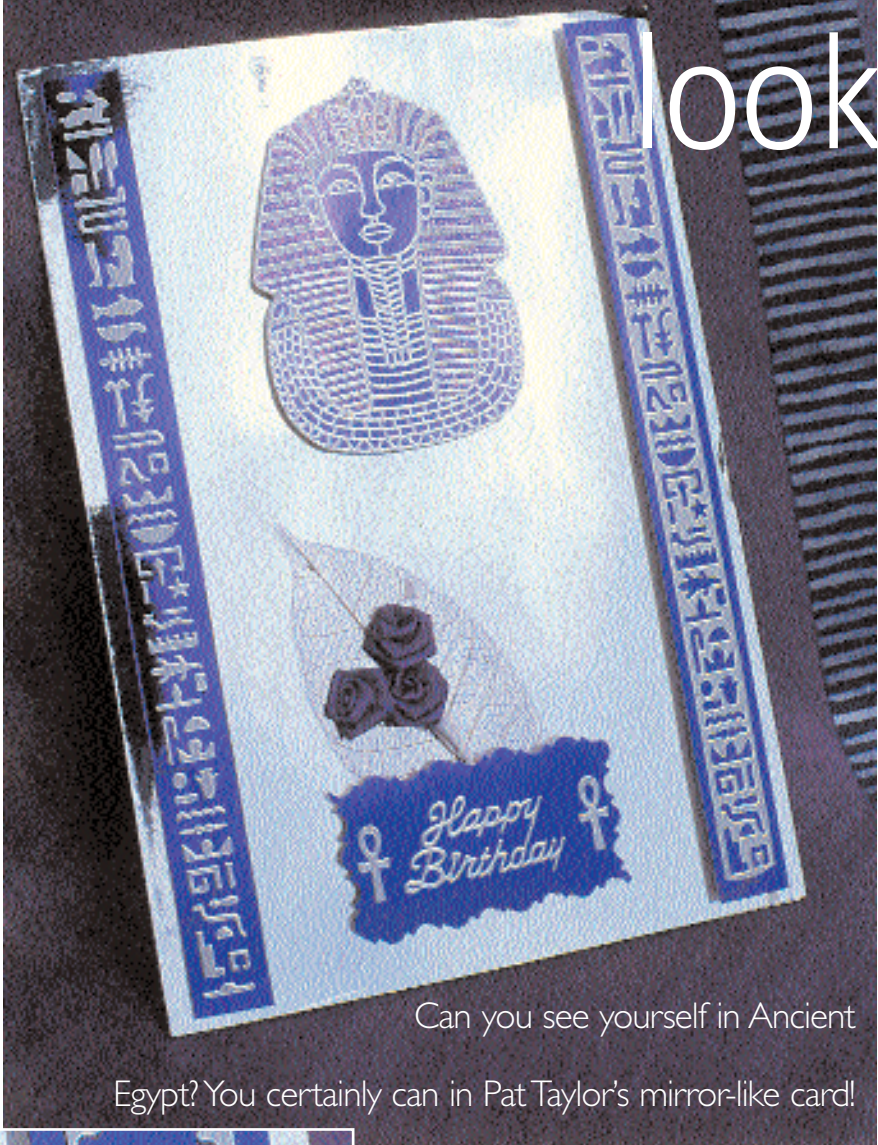


Egypt through the looking glass



Can you see yourself in Ancient Egypt? You certainly can in Pat Taylor's mirror-like card!

slowly lift the tape. All the pieces should be transferred.

Place the tape onto purple Mirri card and rub over it firmly. Slowly lift the tape and pieces should now be on the card.

STEP 3

Cut the hieroglyphs into two equal strips with a craft knife and cutting mat.

STEP 4

Put a greeting onto purple Mirri card and cut out with decorative scissors.



STEP 5

Place 3D foam squares on the back of all purple Mirri card pieces.

STEP 6

Measure centre of A4 silver Mirri card, top and bottom, score on wrong side and fold in half.

STEP 7

Stick one strip down each outside edge of card and put King Tut in the centre at the top. Stick leaf and ribbon roses below and finally place sentiment over the top.

GET READY...

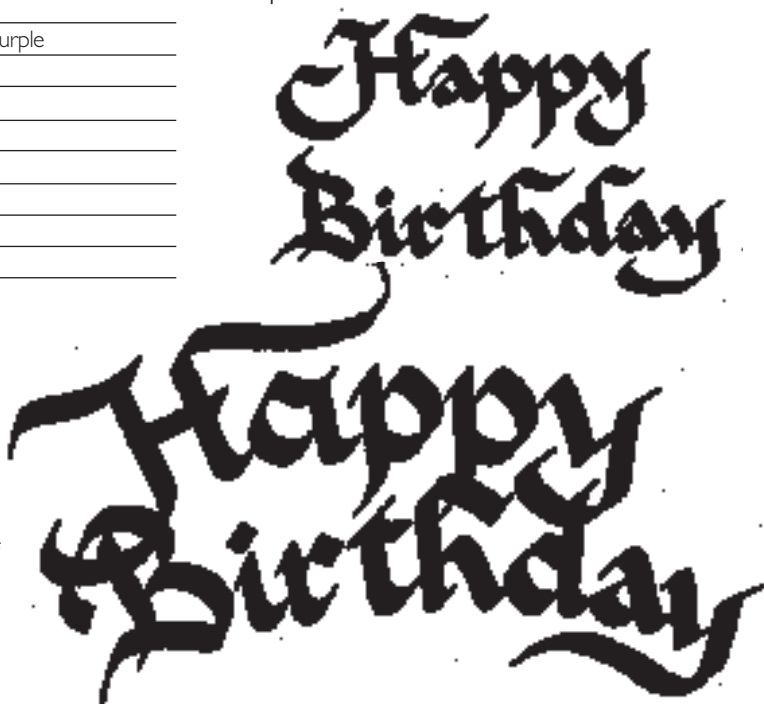
- Kanban Mirri card in silver and purple
- Egyptian peel-off sheet 1015
- Purple ribbon roses
- Purple skeleton leaf
- Masking tape
- PSX Diamond Sparkles
- Anitas Victorian Scissors
- 3D foam squares

GO STEP 1

Place King Tut peel-off onto purple Mirri card, cut out and highlight with Diamond Sparkles.

STEP 2

Carefully place left hand strip of hieroglyphs from the peel-off sheet onto purple Mirri card. Place masking tape over the peel off bits left behind, press down hard and

Try the Egyptian look on parchment, too, with Anne Hills' double offering.



can be just embossed or coloured. I embossed half the pyramids on the back and then coloured with brown felt tip pen, again from the back. Colour back of face with pale brown felt tip.



Tutankhamun card

STEP 1

Trace and emboss your choice of border round folded piece of A4 parchment.

STEP 2

Position Tutankhamun mask peel-off along with the pyramids at the bottom of the card. Trace and emboss a greeting.

STEP 3

Emboss every segment of the mask on the back with a large-ball tool then colour sections on the front with gold Pilot pen. Colour the mask stripes alternately with blue felt tip and gold Pilot pen. Use a mid blue, like lapis lazuli.

When the gold ink has dried you may need to re-emboss the stripes a little as they sink after colouring.

STEP 4

Position a few hieroglyphics down each side. These

Card with figures

STEP 1

Cut edge of folded A4 parchment with decorative scissors.

STEP 2

Pop on the figures, two peel-off columns and little hieroglyphic shapes across the bottom or top to form borders.

STEP 3

Trace and emboss a greeting. Emboss parts of the figures and colour on the back with felt tip pens.

STEP 4

Add a rainbow paper insert.
