To Mum

- 1 Cut and fold white card to create a 13.5cm square card blank. Cut pink paper to 13.5x7.2cm and attach to the bottom of the card.
- 2 Use a pencil to trace the bottom half of template one onto the pink paper on the bottom of the card front. Go over the pencil lines with a white Gelly Roll pen. Allow to dry and then rub out any visible lines.
- 3 Repeat step two on the top of the card front tracing the top half of the template - you do not need to trace the two flowers. Draw over the pencil lines in pink.
- 4 Mount a 5x4.6cm pink paper rectangle onto a 6x5.5cm piece of white card. Ink the edges of the white card with Port Wine ink.
- 5 Trace the two flowers from the top half of template one onto the pink card and draw over the lines in white.

- 6 Cut a 2x2.2cm and a 3x2.1cm rectangle from white card. Ink the edges of one with Savoy Green and the other with Whisper Blue. Attach alphabet letters to each as shown.

- 7 Add a green eyelet in the centre of each side of the white card and secure to the card front with foam pads. For the finishing touch add blue Gelly Roll dots to the butterfly wings on the bottom of the card.

You're the best

- 1 Cut a 21x10.5cm piece of white card. Fold to make a 10.5cm square gatefold card blank.
- 2 Trace template two onto the card front and draw over the lines with Gelly Roll pens. Once dry rub out any visible lines.
- 3 Frame the card by edging it with a blue Gelly Roll pen. Highlight some of the flowers with blue and pink chalks and add the 'heartfelt' rub-on in the bottom right corner.
- 4 Cut a 7x11cm strip of white card and add the 'you're the best rub-on'. Draw on some flowers in pink or trace them from the template if you wish. Edge the strip with a blue pen and pink and blue chalk highlights.

- 5 Ink the strip with clear ink, add clear embossing powder and heat set.

- 6 Add a blue eyelet in the bottom right of the strip. Thread flower embellishments onto blue craft wire and secure to the strip by threading the wire through the eyelet and twisting the ends.

- 7 Attach the strip to the card front as shown and for the finishing touch add a pink insert.



From the heart

This variation of the 'you're the best' card was made using template three. The edges of the card front were edged with a pink Gelly Roll pen and pink chalk highlights were added to some of the stripes. Beyond Postmarks Brenda Walton Friendship Rub-ons by K&Company were used along with a Making Memories Primitive Silver Heart eyelet. The hearts and the edge of the plaque were highlighted with silver accent beads.
